### **Out of Joint**

We had a visitor to our home recently that caused a little disruption to one occupant of our home. It seems that the high energy of a puppy is not what a three-year-old dog gets excited about. The audacity of an intruder coming in with a cuteness factor of 10 on a scale of 1 to 10 is not what makes one always welcome. After all, the three-year-old was once the cute puppy himself. But the stature of a little ball of fur compared to a ninety-pound dog leaves one at a distinct disadvantage. What does not help is that the puppy instantly gained the attention of all in the house simply by walking in. This is a lot to deal with as the one who is used to being the center of attention. When this happens to us we can feel the pain the grown dog was feeling. This out of joint attitude is not reserved to only dogs though. It seems we too can be caught out of joint at times in our lives.

The people of Israel had the same kind of issue with the "ownership" of God. They did not want to share the good thing they had going with the only true God who could move mountains, separate the sea to form dry ground and cause war to cease. Having God all to themselves was a great advantage they did not want to share at all, it seemed. Still the nature of being God's chosen people came with the intention of showing the benefits of having the Divine on their side so others would want to follow.

Are we also guilty of the same thought? Do we also wish to keep God for ourselves? This is an easy habit to get into. If we have to share the saving power of God we may not like what it may look like. Change in the way we do things is not always welcome in our hearts but in changing times may be a necessary way of life. In the church we are called to be the living Body of Christ. Any living being is subject to change that occurs simply because that is what living does to us. We change! Look in the mirror and we can see we are not who we were even a few years ago. Waist lines seem to expand for no good reason. Hair changes color or in some of us thins of leaves areas completely. Change happens.



Just think about what life would be like if everyone we met on the streets were a believer? How exciting it would be to greet everyone as a brother or sister in Christ. With no room for jealousy we can learn from each other and praise God in new and beautiful ways.
