Council Notes of January 4, 2025

The council meeting of January 4th, 2025 was opened by the reading of Ephesians 1: 15-20. Prayer was given by Ken Mehmen.

Article 1: Minutes of the December 8th, 2025 meeting were read and approved.

Article 2: No Correspondence was received.

Article 3: Ministry Reports and Concerns

- Elders Report: Discussion was held on potential pastoral visits in January.
- Pulpit Committee:

- Attendance Report: There was an Average Attendance of 43.5 people with 17.8 people live streaming.
- Outreach Committee: No Report
- Discipleship Committee: Catechism and Sunday School classes will resume January 11th.
- Building and Grounds Committee: No Report

Article 4: Financial Reports and Concerns

- Receipts of \$14,404.42 was received. Budget amount of \$9,185.20 is needed. Giving us \$5,219.22 for the month. With a YTD of -\$2,132.49 from Budget.
- Actual Year End 2025 Expenses were less than budgeted; including an estimated pastor expense, the actual YTD balance is a surplus of \$1,061.01. If interest income from church bank accounts is included and including an estimated pastor expense YTD balance is a surplus of \$12,348.08.

Article 6: Old Business

- Phone service will switch to Verizon on 1/10/26. Church phone number will remain the same.
- The Search Committee invited potential candidate Pastor Kevin Van Wyk to an in-person interview on January 3rd. Pastor Van Wyk was also asked to provide pulpit supply on January 4th.
- A sample outreach card intended to share information about our church was presented to the council for review. Revision suggestions were offered. The card will be revised and resubmitted.

Article 7: New Business

- Stacy Ascher joined the council meeting to share feedback from the search committee on potential candidate Pastor Kevin Van Wyk, followed by council discussion.
- Discussion was held regarding the future schedule for special offerings.
