Our Missionary News: Mike and Victoria VanDerDyke are still in the U.S. and waiting for the airports in Nigeria to open so they can return to their work. They have been living with their children in the Chicago area. As of June 29, there were 25,133 cases of Covid with 573 deaths. Plateau State (where they live) has had 371 confirmed cases with 9 deaths. Also, on June 1st Emmanuel and Juliana (a CRC pastor of a church in Mararraba) were killed during inter-tribal violence. They leave behind 8 children between the ages of 1 and 19. Pray for the children and the that the violence will come to an end. Council Notes of July 6, 2020

Council meeting of July 6, 2020 was opened by reading and discussing the Healthy Church materials. Scripture was read from II Corinthians 8:1-15 and discussion centered on "Generous Stewardship." The Scriptures emphasize that good stewardship is evident in healthy churches and that stewardship is a gift of God. Opening prayer by Pastor Rus.

Article 1: Minutes of the June 1st council meeting were read and approved.

Article 2: No new Correspondence was received.

Article 3: Ministry Reports:

• Pastor's Report: Monthly report of visits, activities and mileage was received for information.

Due to lack of opportunity to meet as committees, no reports were shared.

• Elder's Report: No report.

• Pulpit Committee: Marlyn Allspach

• Worship Committee: Dale Meester

• Attendance: Clayton Groeneveld

• Outreach Committee: Marlyn Allspach

• Discipleship Committee: Pat Prier,

• Building Committee: Pastor Rus shared two items from the building committee:

- 1. The dehumidifier in the church basement was no longer working. A motion was made and accepted to purchase a new dehumidifier at a cost up to \$300.
- 2. The church fire extinguishers were checked and found to be adequate.

Article 4: The June 2020 financial report was presented. Receipts of **\$8234.53** were received. The target monthly budget amount (with 4 Sundays in the month) is <u>\$8280.80</u> which results in a monthly shortfall of <u>\$46.27</u>. YTD shortfall is <u>\$3285.78</u>.

Article 5: Old Business

• Discussion continued regarding the number of Elders and Deacons our church should use and whether the time was appropriate to move to a 3-Elder and 3-Deacon format. A motion was made and approved to elect 1 Elder at this time to

- join the 2 returning Elders on the new Council. At the upcoming Congregational Meeting on August 2, one candidate will be chosen from 2 nominations to serve a 3-year term as Elder.
- Similar discussions took place regarding the number of Deacons needed for the new Council. A motion was made and approved to reduce the number of Deacons from 4 to 3. Council will present 3 candidates for the office of Deacon, with 2 candidates chosen. One Deacon will serve a term of 2-Years and the other Deacon will serve a term of 3-Years.
- This new organizational plan will be presented to the Congregation for their approval prior to the selection process at the Congregational Meeting scheduled for August 2.

Article 6: New Business

• Plans are being made to celebrate Communion on Sunday, July 19. The COVID-19 virus will change the way we normally celebrate Communion since we will not be passing the bread and juice. We are planning to have members come to the front of the church to take the elements. Those unable to walk to the front of the church will be served in their places by the Elders.

Article 7: Motion made and supported to adjourn. Carried

Article 8: Concept minutes were read and approved.

Article 9: Dale Meester closed with prayer. Next meeting: August 3, 2020 at 7:00 pm
