Pastor: Already in the Old Testament, there are references to the Holy Spirit. In Psalm 51 David pleads with God that He not take the Holy Spirit from him. In Isaiah the people are reminded of the leading of the Lord their Shepherd, and His sending of the Holy Spirit among them. Often the pouring out of God's Spirit is mentioned. In 10e1 3 we read:

All: "I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and

daughters will prophecy. Your Old men will dream dreams, and your young men will see visions. Even on my servants, both men and women, will I pour out my Spirit in those days. I will show wonders in the heavens and on the earth."

Song: Psalter 393 Creator Spirit, By Whose Aid

Pastor: Jesus Promised His disciples that He would send the Holy Spirit, the Counselor. That Spirit would convict men of sin and would lead and guide them in the way everlasting. That is the Holy Spirit who was poured out on the Day of Pentecost—the Holy Spirit who dwells within us. That Spirit is vital to us today. That Spirit has been given to us personally so we might share in Christ.

All: "Now it is God who makes both us and you stand firm in Christ. He appointed us, set His seal of ownership on us, and put His Spirit in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come." (II Corinthians 1:21-22)

Pastor: Another role of the Holy Spirit is to be our Comforter. The New Testament church experienced this. "The Church, throughout Judea enjoys a time of peace. It was strengthened and encouraged by the Holy Spirit ..." (Acts 9:31)

All: "In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express. And He who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints in accordance with God's will." (Romans 8: 26-27)

Pastor: And we have the beautiful promise that the Holy Spirit will remain with us forever.

All: "And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Counselor to be with you forever, the Spirit of truth." (John 14:16)
