Two Words

Mary and I recently returned from a week long stay at a retreat in Colorado. While there we were treated to a time of rest and reflection. This time was spent being served wonderful meals and time to simply unwind from the business of ministry. At the wrap up of the week the leaders asked what we took away form the time at the retreat. I was able to give my thoughts with two words, "Selah and shalom."

The first word, as you may know is found in Psalms and used as a musical direction, meaning "pause" and consider what came before. In ministry this is something that should be done from time to time to simply take time to look back to see where God has shown up. Seeing where God brought grace when it was unexpected or removed challenges is important for seeing his faithfulness in all things. Pausing to remember helps to link the pieces together.

Many of us are also familiar with shalom. We know it means peace in a powerful way. This shalom is even more amazing when we seek it in the light of pausing to reflect on God's faithfulness. Knowing the past gives us reason to trust that we can trust God with our future with confidence. This is the power of shalom, God's peace through grace.

These two words describe the week we had. A time to clear the mind and seek the guiet solitude where trust is strengthened and energy renewed. This time is important for pastors from time to time, even without spending a week at a retreat. How about all Christians?

When was the last time you paused from the business of life for even an hour or so to reflect on how God has blessed you in your walk with him? Looking back is a wonderful way to see the blessings we often are too busy to see. When we have the clarity of vision to see because of the unmistakable presence of God in our lives can we have the light of undarkened hope for the future.

We all desire shalom. The most complete peace comes when we have our faith strengthened through our memories of grace in the past. The goodness of God never changing is the promise he makes us, so what are we waiting for? Make time this day or at least this week to pause and then find peace. To produce a victory.


Some came back; some didn't.
