Our maturing should have us proclaiming our dependence on God not our feeble attempt to get away. Through our open reliance on the guiding hand of God we testify to our identity. A child of God should always seek and welcome this power of the love God has for us.

Are you held in the Father's hand? If not who has pulled away? God is reaching out in love. Take hold of Him and enjoy the comfort of His care while you still can.


